

For nearly 20 years, The Story of Stuff Project has inspired changemakers around the world with our storytelling and campaigns. **But did you know we have a Grassroots Grants Program that's awarded \$500,000 to local environmental groups?** In 2025 we're looking for additional donors to help us invest in local partners working on some of the most pressing issues of our time.



#### THE NEED:

History teaches us that great power lies in the hands of everyday heroes united for a common goal. Local communities directly affected by environmental problems have powerful ideas. They're invested in improving their neighborhoods and are best poised to bring about innovative, scalable, impactful solutions. **Yet these frontline communities frequently lack the funding and capacity to realize their vision.** This is particularly relevant for underresourced groups led by and serving Black, Indigenous, People of Color (BIPOC); youth and retirees; and low-income communities.

## **OUR SOLUTION: THE GRASSROOTS GRANTS PROGRAM**



In a little under 10 years **our Grassroots Grants Program has already sown the seeds of transformation in countless communities.** We believe in the power of local action and are committed to empowering those on the groundworking closest to the challenges we face to create meaningful change. We offer:

- Seed funding to start up organizations
- Financial support for special projects and campaigns
- Capacity building support in communications, campaigns, and networking
- Visibility and promotion to our Community on social

# **IMPACT AND SUCCESS STORIES**

Our Grassroots Grant Program evolved alongside half a dozen community groups fighting back against water privatization by bottling giant Nestlé. Story of Stuff learned quickly that for these local groups, **a few thousand dollars can have a significant impact.** In addition to funding, The Story of Stuff Project built the capacity of these local champions through storytelling, campaign strategy development, coalition building, and legal support, resulting in **historic water justice victories** in places like Oregon, California, Pennsylvania, and Canada.



# **TENACIOUS UNDERDOGS**

Our Grassroots Grants Program leverages our global Community of changemakers to provide direct financial support to grassroots environmental sustainability and justice initiatives. Our often volunteer-led grantees have fought to protect half a dozen rivers and creeks from being drained by the largest global water bottling companies. We've provided rapid response grants to frontline communities experiencing climate emergencies ranging from devastating hurricanes, irreversible industrial accidents, and displacement in urban and rural places. And whether it's an intergenerational project to promote urban farming in Baltimore, a student organization protesting toxins and waste incineration, or an all volunteer organization of seniors fighting illegal corporate takeovers of public lands, we've invested in tenacious underdogs. To date, we have awarded half a million dollars through 150 grants averaging \$3,500 in every region of the U.S.

## **CREATING CHANGE AT THE GROUND LEVEL**
